



**NOTES:**

1. It is essential that both the make and the type of the equipment and the antenna be clearly specified e.g. make: Motorola, type P110.
2. Section D.1 requires the frequency band for which the equipment is designed.
3. For all systems the geographical coordinates for each fixed station **must** be furnished in degrees and minutes (East and South).
4. The required area of communication **must** be expressed in a kilometre radius from the fixed/base station or any other fixed point.
5. Each application **must** be accompanied by two copies of the agreement duly completed.
6. All the necessary fee's **must** accompany the application.

# CONDITIONS OF ISSUE OF PRIVATE RADIOCOMMUNICATION LICENSES

**IMPORTANT NOTE : PLEASE READ THROUGH THE CONDITIONS AS IT IS OF UTMOST IMPORATANCE**

1. Licenses shall be temporary and may be withdrawn at any time.
2. Communication between fixed stations is prohibited unless approved by the NCC.
3. Extensions to the public telephone network is prohibited unless approved by the NCC.
4. The licensed station shall be operated only by reliable persons appointed by the licensee.
5. The licensee shall not divulge to any person (other than properly authorized officials of the Communication Commission or a competent judiciary tribunal), or make any use of whatever of, any message coming to the knowledge of the licensee and not intended for receipt by means of the licensed apparatus.
6. Each station SHALL transmit its official allocated CALL SIGN at least once during the course of transmission. The call sign should be displayed on the radio set.
7. If the licensee is at any time required to make technical or other modifications to his radio-communication system, he shall arrange for such modification to be done without claim for compensation for any financial or other loss sustained as a result of such modifications.
8. Radio apparatus shall not be acquired for the establishment of a radio-communication service or for the extension of an existing radio-communication service, unless the Commission have issued an appropriate license. Radio apparatus SHALL NOT BE DISPOSED of to ANOTHER USER without prior permission of the Commission.
9. Only type approved radio apparatus that conforms to NCC specifications shall be used for a licensed radio-communication service.
10. Radio apparatus authorized for installation at a fixed point SHALL NOT BE TRANSFERRED to any other point without prior written permission of the Commission.
11. The radio apparatus should be used solely for the purpose stated in the application. Transmission of music or entertainment of any kind or anything of a blasphemous, indecent, obscene, offensive or libellous nature is strictly forbidden.
12. The licensee shall undertake to maintain the radio apparatus in good technical order (in particular the fixed and/or repeater stations) to ensure that it complies with the NCC's technical requirements at all times and that it does not cause interference with other radio users.
13. The apparatus at the licensed station shall be subject to inspection by officials authorized by the Commission at all reasonable times.
14. A license is valid for the specific area as prescribed on the license.
15. Licenses shall expire on the 31'st of December of the year during which the license are issued. If annual license fee's is not paid the license will become invalid. Fee's are payable to the NCC and according to the Government Gazette tariff's.
16. It is possible that the assigned frequency may also be assigned by the NCC to be shared with other users.
17. Spurious radiation's, including harmonic emissions and intermodulation products, shall conform to the requirements laid down in the Government Gazette.
18. Frequencies within the band 26,96 to 27.28 MHz are primarily designated for industrial, scientific and medical purposes. Users of radio-communication services operating within the limits of these shall accept unconditionally and harmful interference as a result of the operation of these equipment. No complaints regarding interference shall be accepted by the NCC.

The issue of private radio-communication licenses is subject to the provisions of the RADIO ACT, 1952 (act3 of 1952), as amended , the Radio Regulations promulgated there-under and such conditions as may be prescribed by the Namibian Communication Commission.
